Example Transnet Freight Rail Masters Work Based Projects

- Possible Benefits of deploying longer trains through optimisation in the Maputo corridor
- Critical evaluation of cash flow forecasting methodologies and process at Transnet Freight Rail
- Utilising virtual (VR) for practical assessment for train drivers in Kaserne depot.
- Evaluating options for a public private partnership model in South Africa heavy haul rail operations
- Exploring the use of global navigation satellite systems for the safe movement and control of trains in South Africa.
- To investigate Communication Based Train Control (CBTC) system as a mechanism to improve railway line capacity on the central corridor
- Evaluating the effectiveness of the current implementation and execution strategy to supply jet fuel to O.R.
 Tambo International Airport considering future investment.
- The introducing of double stacking of containers on rail between Belville container terminal and the port of Table Bay, in order to improve customer satisfaction.
